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Byzantine lead seals from the Karaman Museum

This brief presentation aims to make a catalogue of the seals in the Karaman Museum, which is situated in central Anatolia, south of Konya, north of Taurus Mountains. The first seal entered the Museum in 1977. According to the Museum records, the second one entered in 1982. Only one out of seventeen came from Manazan cave cleaning in 1991. Most of the specimen are from Adana, and they were sold to the Karaman Museum at various times. Though the collection is quite small, it includes interesting specimens, and is developing through purchasing from individuals every year. This study can be assumed as the beginning of a detailed study, which plans to record and share this unknown collection with other scholars.
